

A Message from Fr. Fulton

Now that we are starting the run-up to Lent, it is a good time to consider our Lenten penances.
Suggestions for choosing a Lenten penance.

1. Choose a penance that will counter and conquer a habitual sin or fault.
2. Choose a penance that is challenging, yet is realistic (one that you can maintain).
3. Be aware that if you choose a challenging penance, you will probably have failures in following it. Failing in your penance does not mean that Lent is over, but in imitation of Jesus carrying his cross, you keep going despite your fall.
4. Your penance should change you in some way, even something that you develop as a practice or habit beyond Lent.
