

## A Message from Fr. Fulton

The word *epiphany* means *manifestation of God*. While there are many epiphany in the Old Testament, New Testament, and Church history, we focus on three epiphanies in January. The first is what we call THE Epiphany, which is the visit to the Infant Jesus at the stable by the three kings. Through the Magi, Jesus was calling the nations to Himself, offering them salvation. Their gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh represent the Jesus' kingship, divinity, and humanity, respectively. The other two epiphanies that we formally observe are the Baptism of the Lord (the manifestation of the Holy Trinity and the designation of water as the matter for sacramental baptism) and the wedding feast at Cana (Jesus' first miracle and the institution of sacramental marriage). Through these epiphanies, we see how Jesus used symbols in order to reveal spiritual and physical truths and how all that Jesus did was according to the plan and orchestration of God the Father.
