

A Message from Fr. Fulton

As you may have read or heard, Cdl. Fernandez announced that the Society of St. Pius X and all who are affiliated with it are excommunicated. What that means for the Society members is that we are going to carry on as usual. While Pope Francis gave us faculties to hear confessions and to witness marriages, Cdl. Fernandez said that those faculties are now removed. Therefore, we will revert to applying supplied jurisdiction when we are administering those sacraments, making them still valid. The inclusion of lay people in the excommunications is questionable, since lay people are not members of the society, and it is not a historical practice to do so. The bottom line is, we are keeping our mission and identity, and living out the Faith reasonably all the while that we are in the midst of the crisis in the Church. We still are what we are.
