The Cross is the universal Christian symbol. It is the sign of our salvation, the meaning of our earthly sufferings, and ultimate guide to Heaven. At the Mass, the Lord's Sacrifice on the Cross is perpetuated every time that the Mass is celebrated. We, in turn, unite our sufferings with this same Sacrifice for our own spiritual growth, for the conversion of others, and to purify ourselves from sin, the devil, the flesh, and the world. Our model for the union of our sufferings with the Lord's sufferings is the Virgin Mary. At the Cross, she united her sufferings with Christ's sufferings, and she also does so during the Mass as the Coredemptrix. As our Mother, we gain from her example, encouragement, and intercession as we grow in understanding and maturity through the Cross as our force and guide to Heaven.
